Requirements

- **High school graduates/equivalent who have a certificate of graduation** (A-level certificate or IB Diploma also permitted) with no more than 5 years when registering.
- **Admission Year 2026 dedicated for High School graduates within 5 years:** 2026, 2025, 2024, 2023, and 2022.
- Minimum IELTS score of **5.5** or minimum TOEFL score of **500** (PBT/ITP) or **61** (iBT) or **173** (CBT)
- Motivational letter that explain your motivation to choose Communication at UI, Essay should be hand-written for submission.

• Talent Scouting

An independent selection pathway based on report card grades and achievements for the International Undergraduate Program. The registration process is conducted by the principal of the school. Only selected high schools participate in the talent scouting program.

• SIMAK Kelas Khusus Internasional (KKI UI)

Written test-based selection. Information could be accessed in website simak.ui.ac.id and enrollment.ui.ac.id
